ORCHARD TOUR ON WEDNESDAY

This year's annual orchard tour will visit WW Farms in Seguin on July 17. The ticketed event will cover three adjacent orchards, each with unique management challenges and practices.

The first orchard is upland and non-irrigated with intensive regenerative farming. The second is a pecan bottom with cattle and a low density of pecan trees. The last orchard on the tour has a very high density of pecan trees and a bottom that's not irrigated with no cattle. We'll end with lunch and conclude the conference.

What does the NPF do?

The NPF advocates for the pecan industry using the services of The Redding Firm. Advocacy takes on various forms and often begins with educating key policymakers about the industry's concerns, and, depending on the issue, might involve partnering with other specialty crop organizations or working with state departments of ag and other industry participants. A well-funded PAC is essential to ensuring the industry's voice is heard in D.C.

What has NPF/PECAN PAC accomplished?

- 1. Millions to producers for disaster assistance, tariff mitigation, and relief efforts
- 2. A 70% reduction in the tariff for pecans going into India
- 3. Research and Promotion authority to assess imported pecans expected to generate \$4,000,000 in additional marketing and research funding.
- 4. \$5,500,000 funding for cracking and pasteurization research
- 5. \$5,500,000 funding for pecan breeding research
- 6. Pecan Crop Insurance reforms
- 7. USDA pecan purchases for feeding programs
- 8. Working to get pecans included in senior, school, and other food programs

What are NPF/PECAN PAC's current priorities?

- 1. Improvements to Federal Pecan Crop Insurance & Tree Loss Insurance
- 2. Processing and breeding research continued funding
- 3. Positioning the industry to benefit from the Biden Administration's carbon sequestration initiatives

To have a successful advocacy program, the pecan industry must have a political action committee. The Pecan PAC can accept contributions from individuals, partnerships, or LLCs. 
